

Intermountain Center for Autism and Child Development (ICACD) 2008 Summer Program

Basic info:

- * What: A morning summer program held from 9:00am to 11:30am, Monday thru Thursday.
- * When: Three two week sessions: first session: June 23rd - July 3rd, second session: July 7th thru 17th, Third session: July 21st thru 31st.
- * Where: Intermountain Center for Autism and Child Development & Community
- * Who: Children ages 3 to 10 (chronological or functional age).
- * Cost: \$200 per week - A \$50 deposit will hold your child's admittance. - Payment is due the first of each week.
- * Size: There will be a 4:1 ratio of children to therapists
- * Parents informational meeting will be held on May 28th at 5pm



What to expect:

- * ICACD Summer Program is designed to provide a positive experience, develop a sense of accomplishment and promote social growth through recreation. This is achieved through the provision of socially and physically safe environments that focus on strengths. Participants will be exposed to comprehensive programming and a rich menu of camp activities on an individual, partner and small group basis. Activities are short duration, sequential and modified to meet the level of each participant.
- * We aim to help your child by challenging them through group work, social interaction, and physical activities; through these tools your child will learn to recognize their strengths and find a place in the social and community settings.
- * Our program will be custom-designed in order to meet the specific needs of each particular child. All activities are purposefully adaptable to accommodate a range of needs, abilities and objectives.
- * Activities will include: Outdoor sports, water days, arts/crafts, drama, nature scavenger hunts, food creations, video sharing, and super activities.
